James Wood Middle School will be hosting their Annual Rising 6th Grade Parent Night on Thursday, February 22, 6:30 p.m.

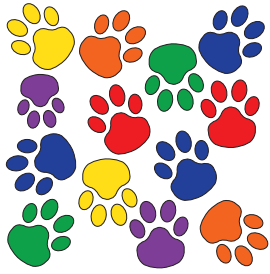
